JAMP is a program in Texas that GUARANTEES admission to a Texas medical school (for students that qualify). It was designed to help economically disadvantaged students who aspire to be physicians through college and medical school.

### **WHAT CAN JAMP DO FOR YOU?**

1. Guaranteed admission to one of the 14 Texas medical schools after college
2. Scholarships of \$1,000 per semester beginning spring of sophomore year
3. Paid summer internships with medical schools (two summers with two different medical schools)
4. Mentoring programs from the medical schools as well as at the collegiate level
5. Medical school scholarships

### **REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR JAMP:**

1. Register with Professional School Advising (OPSA)
2. Texas Residency and U.S. Citizenship
3. FAFSA SAI between \$-1500 up to \$7000
4. Complete 27 hours your freshman year with at least a 3.25 GPA
5. Complete both CHEM 119 and CHEM 120 freshman year
6. Complete CHEM 257 fall of sophomore year
7. Must have fulltime status every semester

### **CONTINUATION AS A JAMP STUDENT:**

1. Maintain a minimum 3.25 overall and science GPA
2. Complete CHEM 258 spring of sophomore year
3. Complete the rest of the medical school prerequisites at Texas A&M University
4. Be able to complete your degree program in four years
5. Success on MCAT (minimum score of 502)
6. Successfully complete 2 summer internships with the medical schools
